57th Annual Conference

The 57th Annual Conference was attended by approximately 381 delegates, including 89 new members approved at the two November Board meetings. These new members have been mailed their certificates. The conference delegates also brought 49 accompanying persons to enjoy the conference and local area, which was held at the Westin Bayshore in Vancouver, B.C.. There were 25 technical papers presented at the conference to the delegates in addition to numerous topics presented at the CUPGA meeting attended by 180 delegates on Sunday. A training session on Roadway Smoothness was held on the Saturday attended by approximately 40 members.

Changes to the Constitution and By Laws

The August Newsletter included a section about changing the Constitution and the By Laws to add a Director from the province of Alberta. The Board of Directors passed the motion at their May 26, 2012 meeting. The members at the Annual General meeting are offered an opportunity to discuss the amendments following which they must vote on a motion to send the amendments to the members at large through a letter ballot.

The present Constitution and By Laws includes reference to five geographical areas and twelve Board members. The Board proposes to change the five to six geographical areas and to change the number of Board members from twelve to fourteen. The reason for the fourteen is, as will be noted in the By Laws, Article 4.1, to allow 3 presidential reps, 6 geographical reps, 2 past presidents, 2 Local Arrangement reps and an opening, if it is ever necessary, to balance the occupational representation on the Board.

The members at the Annual General Meeting approved amendments to the Constitution and By Laws to add a Director. Furthermore they also voted in favour of taking the proposed amendments to Article 3 of the Constitution and Articles 4.1 and 6.2 of the By Laws to a letter ballot.

These changes and voting ballots will be sent out with the membership invoices with a return date of April 15, 2013.

The motion will be:

Amend Article 3 of the Constitution and Articles 4.1 and 6.2 of the By Laws of the Canadian Technical Asphalt Association to read as follows:

Article 3 of the Constitution

3. The Management of the Association shall consist of a Board of Directors composed of no less than nine and no more than ~~twelve~~ fourteen Members, providing that the ~~five~~ six geographical regions of Canada, i.e. Atlantic Provinces, Quebec, Ontario, Prairie Provinces and Territories, Alberta, and British Columbia are suitably represented.

Articles 4.1 and 6.2 of the By Laws

- 4.1 The business of the Association shall be managed by a Board of Directors comprised of a President, a First Vice-President, a Second Vice-President, ~~five~~ six Directors-at-large, one from each geographic region, the two latest living Past Presidents who continue to be members of the Association, and such additional maximum of ~~two~~ one Directors as the Board of Directors shall appoint to provide balanced occupational representation. In addition, the chair (or one of the co-chairs) of the local arrangements committees organizing the current and following Annual CTAA Conferences shall be appointed to the Board of Directors as non-voting members for an appropriate period, but not to exceed two years. No Director shall be less than eighteen years of age.
- 6.2 In odd-numbered years, the Nominating committee will put forward the names of candidates for election to the Board of Directors from the regions of Atlantic Provinces, Ontario and ~~British Columbia~~ Alberta. In even-numbered years, the Nominating Committee will put forward names of candidates for election to the Board of Directors from the regions of Quebec and the, Prairie Provinces and Territories, and British Columbia.

The ballot will show one Motion with “Agree” or “Disagree”.

Annual Membership Dues

We wish to remind those that paid the non-member fee to attend the Conference in Vancouver **only paid fees for membership** in the Association for the year **2012** and dues are now payable for **2013**.

Invoices for 2013 annual dues will be mailed early next week. Members are asked to ensure that the second (yellow) copy of the invoice accompany all payments so that identification of the payee can be easily made. Members who do not pay by Mid-April will be re-invoiced. Your co-operation in a speedy payment is appreciated.

If a member is to be replaced by another person in an organization then a new application must be forwarded. Automatic membership turnover to a succeeding employee within an organization is not possible unless the proposed member submits an application for approval by the Board. Approvals are made at the Board meetings in May and in November. A link to the current year's application form can be found on the "[Join / Contact / Order Form](#)" page on the web site.

Please note that the invoices include mailing address, telephone-

and facsimile numbers, and e-mail addresses. If there are any corrections, please show the changes and/or additions on the yellow copy of the invoice returned with your payment. Some organization's finance departments do not send the yellow copy with the cheque so perhaps a reminder to them to do so would be in order. There is included also on the invoice the option of donating to the Scholarship fund.

New this year is a choice on the invoice regarding our Proceedings. Some members have indicated they would be satisfied with the CD only. Please record your preference when returning payment whether you wish the Proceedings and CD OR the CD only.

Members who are employed by government organizations are exempt from GST or HST **ONLY** if the government body is paying the

invoice. Exemption numbers should be recorded on the yellow copy of the invoice. If paying on line through the Renew Membership Dues link, please indicate in either Professional Qualifications or Experience fields the GST/HST exemption number. Invoices paid by personal cheque, money order, or personal credit card **MUST** include GST/HST. Members who have not paid their dues by **July 31, 2013** will be placed on the suspended list and their names will not appear in the **2013** copy of the **Proceedings**.

Visa and MasterCard are the only credit cards accepted by CTAA for all payments to the Association. Please ensure the name of the card-holder is included with the payment if different than the member's name.

As a reminder, to access the "Members Only" section of the site, your user name is now your member number and your password is your last name. Both are case sensitive and should be entered as they appear on your invoice or your membership card which you will receive with your 2013 receipt for dues paid. 2012 SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Mr. Peter Salah, a Masters student at Dalhousie University, was the recipient of the 2012 CTAA Open Scholarship and **Mr. Joshua Stipancic**, Applied Science degree at the University of Waterloo, was the recipient of the 2012 CTAA Industry Scholarship. The scholarships were each valued at \$2,000.

CTAA Head Office will send out notices to approximately 50 universities, colleges and technical schools that have been identified as having courses pertaining to asphalt technology. Members may know of interested students that are not privy to the scholarship information and if so, please have them contact our office.

The Scholarship fund is in the

order of \$150,000 and hopefully will be self-sustaining in the near future. Donations are always gratefully welcomed. The scholarship eligibility requirements are as follows:

CTAA Open Scholarship

The CTAA Open Scholarship will be presented to a student who has been admitted into, or is currently enrolled in, a technical college or a university program leading to a diploma or an undergraduate degree which contributes to advances in any facet of asphalt technology. Eligible fields of study include chemistry, chemical engineering, and construction or civil engineering. Other areas of study may be considered provided the applicant clearly notes the relevance of his/her curriculum towards asphalt

technology.

CTAA Asphalt Industry Scholarship

The CTAA Asphalt Industry Scholarship will be presented to a student who has been admitted into, or is currently enrolled in, a technical college or a university program leading to a diploma or an undergraduate degree which contributes to advances in any facet of asphalt technology. Eligible fields of study include chemistry, chemical engineering, and construction or civil engineering. Other areas of study may be considered provided the applicant clearly notes the relevance of his/her curriculum towards asphalt technology. Applicants with industrial experience in asphalt technology are encouraged to apply.

2013 Annual Conference St. John's, Newfoundland

The 2013 Conference, chaired by Brandon MacDonald, will be held at Sheraton Hotel Newfoundland in St. John's, Newfoundland, from Sunday, November 17 to Wednesday, November 20. Room rates have been set at \$169 for a Traditional Guest Room. Deluxe rooms and suites will be available at higher rates.

The training session which has been held on Saturday will now be held on Sunday morning. The July Newsletter will include additional and up-to-date information regarding the Sunday functions.
